Venue. Palanga - is a seaside resort town in western Lithuania, on the shore of the Baltic Sea. It is the most famous Lithuanian seaside resort and is a popular holiday destination place because of the superb white sandy beaches.

Transportation to the venue

Palanga airport. Palanga airport is situated only 7 kilometers off the city. The city can be reached by bus or by taxi. A trip to Palanga city takes 10 min and costs about 15 EUR.

Vilnius airport. <u>Vilnius airport</u> is about 330 km from Vilnius to Palanga. Take an express minibus <u>Vilnius airport-Klaipėda</u>, or a <u>train Vilnius-Klaipėda</u>, and then a <u>bus Klaipėda-Palanga</u>. Another option is to take a <u>bus Vilnius-Palanga</u>.

Kaunas airport. <u>Kaunas airport</u> is situated 10 kilometers off the city. It's about 240 km from Kaunas to Palanga. Take a <u>bus Kaunas-Palanga</u>.

Riga airport. Riga airport is situated 272 km from Palanga. There are flights, buses from Riga to Palanga.

Expected group size is 50 doctoral students.


ECTS credits: 2.0 and a certificate of participation.




Weather
